Peace and Joy!

The ongoing developments on COVID-19 prompt SSAMarikina to take measures on the remaining weeks of the current school year which ends in April 2020. The cancellation of classes by the Executive Order of Marikina Mayor Marcelino R. Teodoro on March 11 followed by President Duterte calling off classes until March 14 and lately until April 12, and the Department of Education press release on social distancing measures have brought the school to the decision to **call off physical classes** for the remaining school days for this school year. Instead, the students will be given the required lessons through Genyo LMS and other online learning tools.

The Grade School, Junior High School, and Senior High School administrators have arranged for online lessons to be provided by the teachers in the schedules given below. The arrangements have been made to ensure that the learning requirements for the grade levels will be provided.

Grade School

Every week, students will receive learning packages from each subject which must be accomplished by the students as these will be included in the computation of the 4th quarter grade.

Junior High School (Grades 7-10)

1. The lesson packages for the remaining topics for the fourth quarter will be sent to students through the GENYO learning management system and other online tools.

3. The lessons scheduled for the day can be accessed within 24 hours. Students should notify the subject teacher immediately if there are problems accessing the lesson.
4. The teachers are available online during the scheduled time to answer queries of students.
5. Summative assessments should be taken by students during the scheduled time.
6. Performance tasks will be online.
7. For students who do NOT have access to the internet:
 - a. They will be given hard copies of the exercises/worksheets upon request.
 - b. Summary quizzes will be given in school.
8. The current grading system will still be followed.

The JHS report cards for the third quarter will be available through GENYO **on March 19, 2020**, except for students with outstanding balance.

Senior High School

The Senior High School Department will engage the learners to accomplish learning tasks by maximizing the existing learning management system of the school and other available on-line tools for the remaining school days.

To meet the learning objectives for the remaining weeks, individual output of students (GENYO) and pair/group output (Google classroom, Hangout Meets) when needed for PETA will be designed by the teachers.

For Grade 12 learners, April 1-3 will be the submission of PETA.

All March school activities of all departments are cancelled.


So far these are the on-line tasks and requirements of the different departments until the end of April, 2020. More detailed requirements are available with the respective department.
